

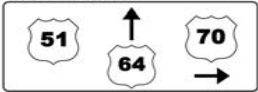

The US 51 highway is potentially unsafe for cars, trucks, pedestrians and farm equipment to be on the road at the same time.

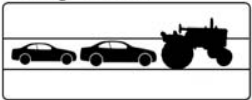
